EXCITING NEWS ABOUT ACCREDITATION FROM OUR PRESCHOOL - The accreditation visitation team from the Evangelical Lutheran Education Association (ELEA) visited our preschool to review documentation, interview teachers and staff, observe our Preschool in operation, and thoroughly investigate all aspects of our Preschool. The Steering Committee under the direction of Katie Kingsbery, the Preschool Board under the direction of Christina Valente, and the teachers under the direction of the Preschool Director, Deanna Klimek have spent the past 18 months in preparation for the accreditation process. We are happy to report the visitation team recommending to the ELEA Accreditation Board that our GSL Preschool receive a full seven year accreditation. We will receive the final report within the next 60 days. The team stated that it is very rare that their recommendation not be approved by the ELEA Board. Congratulations to our Preschool and to everyone who worked so diligently during this process to make it successful.
