HIGHLIGHTS:

- Registration forms are due to GSLP by **Friday, January 15th, 2010**;
- GSLP continues to be one of the few area preschools offering a **4-hour program** for two-year olds through Transitional Kindergarten;
- We provide **Music & Movement class every day** and **Chapel weekly**;
- **Weekly French language class** is offered to all 4 year-olds and Transitional Kindergarten students;
- **5-day program for 3 year-olds added** to class options;
- **Prepayment of May 2010 tuition is NOT required**;
- **Tuition rates are UNCHANGED from the 2009-2010 school year**;
- **Registration fees, where there are 2 or more children enrolled in the school, may be paid as follows: 50% at registration and the balance paid by NO LATER THAN Friday, March 5th, 2010**;
- The school year begins **Monday, August 30th, 2010 and ends Friday, May 20th, 2011**.

Registration Fee is equal to one month's tuition and is non-refundable unless the family moves out of Raleigh by 8/1/10 and provides proof thereof.

Registration Fee is due and payable at registration (1/15/10), unless the family is enrolling 2 or more children at GSLP. If so, the family may pay 50% of the the total due at registration and the remaining balance by NO LATER THAN 3/5/10. If payment is not received, the family is subject to a \$25 late fee and loss of their children's placement in the program.
